The Existence of God

The Bible does not seek to prove the existence of God. The fact that there is a God is taught throughout the scriptures. The first verse of the Bible declares that there is a God. Genesis 1:1 states, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." God's existence is presented as a statement of fact that needs no proof. As we look at the world around us, we can clearly see the work of God. The detailed design which we see in creation declares that there is a creator (see Romans 1:20-21).

Attributes of God

The attributes of God are clearly seen throughout the Bible. God is: all-present (Jer 23:23-24), all-powerful (Jer 32:17 & 27), all-knowing (Job 34:21), eternal (Deut 33:27), holy (Isaiah 6:3), righteous (Psalm 145:17), merciful (Deut 4:31), faithful (Deut 7:9), unchanging (Malachi 3:6), awesome (Deut 7:21).

God's character is the same in both the Old and New Testaments. God is a God of love, Who righteously judges the nations. He is to be revered.
