What is discipleship?

In 1 Corinthians 11:1 Paul writes: *"Imitate me, just as I also imitate Christ."* Paul gives instruction to the Corinthian church on how they should live and tells them to follow in his example. Discipleship is an opportunity to spend structured time with a more mature man in the Lord going

through the Bible, praying, and getting insight into having a more consistent walk with the Lord. Discipleship is for the new believer in Jesus who wants to know what life is supposed to look like following Christ and for an older believer who wants to be challenged to grow deeper and be more consistent in their walk with Christ.

Goals of Discipleship:

Our goal in discipleship is to teach, demonstrate, and encourage a life that is lived full on for Jesus. We plan to cheer you on to live a life pleasing to the Lord. We will focus on the following aspects of our faith:

1. Developing a consistent quiet time (study of God's Word)
2. Developing a healthy prayer life
3. Establishing healthy accountability
4. Encouraging a lifestyle of availability to the Lord (evangelism & service)

Expectations for Discipleship:

1. Through the discipleship process, your discipler may provide Biblical counseling and suggestions. It is up to you to make healthy choices but we expect that you respect the direction and counseling given by your discipler. We take the Lord and His Word seriously and want to challenge each other to the standard which God has given us. We expect that you take the advice and counsel given with humility and prayerfully consider the application of it.
2. We expect you to be consistent in meeting with your discipler and preparing for discipleship appointments
3. We expect that you will not settle for mediocre living but are willing to be challenge to grow deeper in your walk with Christ
4. We want you to feel comfortable sharing areas in your life that you are struggling with so we can hold you accountable. If you are going through a crisis situation (considering suicide, divorce, in an abusive relationship, dealing with mental illness, or any other crisis situation) we expect that your discipler will consult with a pastor of Shoreline Calvary Chapel for further assistance in best serving you. We are not here to condemn but to help you live victoriously in Christ.

We do not expect perfection but that you would be serious about the Lord and the discipleship process. By signing this, you agree to meet with the previously listed expectations. May God bless you as you seek to grow in your relationship with Him!
